## L.A. County Polls Open for the Nov. 5, 2013 Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds voters this morning that all 839 polling places in L.A. County are now open for the Nov. 5, 2013 Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections. Polls opened at 7 a.m. today and close at 8 p.m.

Voters can go online to look up their polling place and view their Sample Ballot Booklet for their precinct. Voters may also obtain information about their voting location by calling the RR/CC's office at (800) 815-2666.
