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## Vote by Mail Request Period Ending for the Nov. 19, 2013 Assembly District 45 Special General Election The deadline to request a Vote by Mail ballot is Nov. 12

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan reminds voters to request a Vote by Mail ballot by Tuesday, Nov. 12 for the Assembly District 45 Special General (Runoff) Election, which takes place on Nov. 19, 2013.

To date, the RR/CC has received 15,525 returned Vote by Mail ballots. More than 88,800 Vote by Mail ballots were mailed, accounting for over 35 percent of the eligible registered voters in Assembly District 45. There are over 250,500 eligible registered voters.

Requesting a Vote by Mail ballot is easy and can be done <u>online</u> or by using the back of the Official Sample Ballot. Registered voters can also apply in person at the RR/CC's main office: 12400 Imperial Hwy., 3rd floor, Room 3002, Norwalk, CA 90650.

L.A. County residents who applied for a Vote by Mail ballot can check the status of their ballot online.

Vote by Mail ballots must be received by the L.A. County RR/CC in Norwalk by 8 p.m. on Election Day. Voters can drop off or mail their ballot to RR/CC headquarters in Norwalk or drop their ballot off at any polling place in L.A. County on Election Day between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. Postmarked envelopes are not accepted.
