Second Ballot Counting Update for the Nov. 5, 2013 Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the second ballot counting update for the Nov. 5, 2013 Local and Municipal Consolidated Elections.

The update includes 4,997 ballots processed since the last ballot counting update on Nov. 8, bringing the total number of ballots processed since Election Night to 29,640. For vote totals on specific contests, visit <u>www.lavote.net</u>.

Please note these results are subject to change throughout the canvass period. The third ballot counting update is scheduled for Friday, Nov. 15 at 1 p.m. All results and updates will be posted online at <u>www.lavote.net</u> as they become available.

The Official Election Canvass period began on Nov. 7 and ends on Nov. 25. During the Official Canvass, all outstanding provisional and Vote by Mail ballots will be verified and tallied. The RR/CC will also conduct a 1% Manual Audit.

On Nov. 25, the RR/CC is tentatively scheduled to certify the results. On Nov. 26, the L.A. County Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election results official.
