First Ballot Count Update for the Dec. 3, 2013 Assembly District 54 Special Primary Election

Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced the first ballot count update for the Dec. 3, 2013 Assembly District 54 Special Primary Election.

As of 8 p.m., 11,351 ballots were counted. This initial figure represents the Vote by Mail Ballots received and processed by the RR/CC.

The Official Election Canvass period begins on Dec. 4 and ends on Dec. 6. During the Official Canvass, all outstanding provisional and Vote by Mail ballots will be verified and tallied. The RR/CC will also conduct a 1% Manual Audit.

On Dec. 13, the RR/CC is tentatively scheduled to certify the results to the California Secretary of State. On Dec. 17, the Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election results official.
